

MARKET COMMENTARY

Stock futures remained flat overnight following two consecutive days of losses for the S&P 500, driven primarily by a broad sell-off in big tech.

Ongoing tensions in Eastern Europe and the Middle East are creating sharp movements in energy and safe-haven assets. Markets closed mixed; notably, defense stocks fell as investors reacted to rumors of a potential peace deal in Ukraine.

From commodity market, oil prices jumped driven by rising tensions in Yemen and heightened friction between Russia and Ukraine, while gold traded higher.

Meanwhile, most regional indices trended lower on Tuesday, echoing Wall Street's concerns regarding a potential "AI bubble". The JCI climbed 1.25% (106.34 points) to close at 8,644.26. Markets are now pivoting toward the start of 2026. Key economic catalysts scheduled for early January include: (1) S&P global manufacturing PMI, (2) latest inflation data and (3) tourist arrival.

CUAN – Enters Negotiations to Acquire Coal Miner Singaraja Putra

Petrindo Jaya Kreasi (CUAN) has announced that it is currently in negotiations regarding an acquisition of Singaraja Putra (SINI), which is expected to result in CUAN holding at least 51% of SINI's shares and becoming its controlling shareholder. Upon consolidation, SINI would contribute coal mining concessions with total reserves of around 378 mn tonnes of thermal and metallurgical coal, potentially positioning CUAN as one of Indonesia's largest coal mining groups. As of 29 Dec 2025, CUAN, through its subsidiary Kreasi Jasa Persada, indirectly owns 19.99% of SINI. (Source : Company)

IMPC – Controlling shareholder sold 411.5 mn shares

The controlling shareholder of Impack Pratama Industri (IMPC), Harimas Tunggal Prakarsa (HTP), sold 411.5 mn shares worth IDR1.3 tn at an average selling price of IDR3,160 per share on December 24, 2025. The transaction was intended to realize investment gains and increase the free-float share count. Following the transaction, HTP holds a 35.6% stake in the company. Note that, IMPC recorded net profit of IDR466 bn (+15.5% yoy) in 9M25. (Source : Investor Daily)

BBLD – Secured loans from 2 banks

Buana Finance (BBLD) has obtained loans totaling IDR950 bn from Bank Danamon and IDR100 bn from Bank OCBC NISP Indonesia. The Bank Danamon facility consists of a term loan of IDR750 bn with a maximum tenor of four years and an additional IDR200 bn with a maximum tenor of two years. Meanwhile, the loan from Bank OCBC NISP Indonesia carries a tenor of two years. The proceeds from these loans will be used to meet working capital needs in the form of consumer finance and financial lease financing. (Source : Kontan)

PRDA – Prepares expansion agenda to strengthen growth in 2026

Prodia Widyahusada (PRDA) is preparing a series of strategic initiatives to strengthen business growth in 2026, with a focus on developing future healthcare services, particularly regenerative therapy, and expanding its cross-border diagnostic network. The company plans to deepen synergies with Prodia Stemcell Indonesia (ProSTEM), where PRDA holds a 30% stake, while targeting a role as a regional reference laboratory in Southeast Asia through partnerships in Timor Leste, Taiwan, and Malaysia. In parallel, PRDA will continue network expansion via new branches and Point of Care (POC), strengthen R&D and digital integration, and deepen B2B and B2C penetration, although recent performance remains under pressure with revenue down 1.1% yoy and net profit declining 41.1% yoy in 9M25. PTPP – Accelerates post-disaster infrastructure recovery in Aceh

PP (PTPP) continues emergency response works on the Bireuen-Takengon road segment in Aceh following hydrometeorological disasters since early December 2025. The company, in coordination with the Ministry of Public Works and local authorities, has deployed field teams and heavy equipment to clear landslides, repair subsided roads, and install temporary bridges, with most affected points restored by 27 December 2025. Management noted that the ongoing response is part of PTPP's social and environmental responsibility program, while coordination is being maintained to align temporary recovery with longer-term permanent infrastructure solutions. ERAA – Strengthens business foundation to support diversification in 2026

Erajaya Swasembada (ERAA) continues to strengthen its business foundation as part of efforts to optimize diversification and improve earnings quality heading into 2026. The company has undertaken a series of affiliated transactions to reinforce capital structure and working capital at its non-gadget businesses, particularly in food & beverage and lifestyle segments, while maintaining dominant ownership across subsidiaries. Management reiterated its focus on diversification, digitalization, operational efficiency, and balanced expansion, with growth expected to be supported by active lifestyle brands and F&B, which offer higher margins compared to the core handset business. SRTK – Expands into global market through international partnership

Lovina Beach Brewery (SRTK) is expanding into the global alcoholic beverage market through a partnership with Singapore-based Coco Bali Pte Ltd to develop and distribute its products internationally. The initial rollout will focus on ready-to-drink (RTD) beverages and spirits, targeting markets across Asia, the US, Europe, and selected Latin American countries, leveraging Bali-sourced ingredients as a key differentiation. Management expects the expansion to support long-term revenue growth and strengthen brand positioning globally, although no near-term financial contribution or targets were disclosed.
