

**MARKET COMMENTARY**

U.S. equities plunged the most in three months on Tuesday (Dow -1.76%, S&P -2.06%, Nasdaq -2.39%) after Trump reignited trade war threats with Europe over Greenland, sparking broad risk-off. In rates and FX, the U.S. 10-year Treasury yield rose +2.8 bps (+0.66%) to 4.27%, while the USD Index weaker -0.49% to 98.56.

Commodities mostly higher: Coal +0.76% to USD112.2/ton on China's plan to add 100 new coal plants; CPO +0.64% to MYR4,095/ton as U.S. finalizes biofuel quota, lifting soy oil; Brent -0.45% to USD63.86/bbl despite Kazakh supply halt, as demand hopes priced in; Gold +1.97% to USD4,762.47/oz, climbed to a record high, breaking a key level as the uncertainty surrounding U.S. demands fueled risk aversion and boosted safe-haven demand.

Asian markets ended lower on Tuesday (Kospi -0.4%, Nikkei -1.1%, Hang Seng -0.3%, Shanghai flat), pressured by renewed U.S. tariff threats on Europe over Greenland and rising political risk in Japan after PM Sanae Takaichi announced a Feb 8 snap election. Meanwhile, the JCI rose slightly by +0.01% to 9,134.7, hitting a new intraday high before paring gains, marking a fifth straight day of increases ahead of Bank Indonesia's rate decision, supported by BRMS, EMAS, and RISE, with foreign net inflows of IDR6.4 bn led by BBRI, PTRO, and BRMS. The rupiah spot weakened 0.05% to IDR16,950/USD, marking its lowest closing level in Indonesia's spot market history.

Asian markets opened mixed on Wednesday (Kospi -1.67%, Nikkei -1.74%). We expect the JCI to trade weaker, supported by regional and global sentiment.

**Automotive – Geely EX2 EV car announced, starting at IDR229.9mn**

Geely Auto Indonesia announced the price of the Geely EX2 electric car for the Indonesian market, starting at IDR 229.9 million. This launch marks Geely's commitment to its global EV sales strategy and strengthens its position in Southeast Asia. The Geely EX2 Pro has a 40.8 kWh battery, a range of up to 395 km, and a local content (TKDN) of 46.5 per cent. The special price is valid for SPK until February 15, 2026, or for the first 2,000 orders. (Source: katadata).

*Comment: Amid the potential landscape competition changes due to several new policies, we believe EV market will remain contributes significantly to overall 4W market. The announcement of the Geely EX2 starting at IDR 229.9 million is a price disruptor, in our view. Yet, post promo (limits to only the first 2,000 units) will determine whether Geely remain as the segment leader (City/Compact 4W EV). Additionally, range anxiety, well developed charging infrastructure, TKDN, after sales services and used / second hand price are remains as several key success factor. Maintain Neutral for automotive sector.*

**INCO – 2026 RKAB Quota Cut**

PT Vale Indonesia Tbk (INCO) confirmed it only secured ~30% of its proposed 2026 nickel ore quota, which management flagged may be insufficient to meet smelter commitments. (Source: Kontan)

**PGAS – Gas Quota Cuts Hits East Java**

PT Perusahaan Gas Negara Tbk (PGAS) notified industrial clients in East Java that January 2026 gas quotas were cut to just 43–68%, with supply only available on select days. Kontan reported that the February HGBT (regulated gas price) allocation has yet to be announced, with industry sources warning of a potential zero gas quota next month, though official confirmation is pending. **KEEN – Signs USD25 mn PPA for 10MW Solar Project**

PT Kencana Energi Lestario Tbk (KEEN), via subsidiary PT Energi Surya Halmahera, signed a 20-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) worth USD25 mn with PLN for the PLTS Tobelo solar project. Construction is set to begin in 2026, with COD targeted for 1Q27. The project will have an installed capacity of 10 MW and include 8.4 MWh of battery storage. (Source: Company)

**ADHI – Targets IDR23.8 tn in new contracts**

Adhi Karya (ADHI) is targeting new contracts worth IDR23.8 tn (+31.49% yoy), with a focus on its engineering and construction business. Previously, ADHI successfully recorded new contracts totaling IDR18.1 tn in 2025, exceeding its target of IDR17 tn. The new contract acquisition was composed of 91% engineering and construction, 5% manufacturing, 3% property and hospitality, and 1% investment and concession. (Source : Kontan)

**SSMS – Putra Borneo Agro acquires shares worth IDR190.0 bn**

Sawit Sumbermas Sarana (SSMS) recorded a significant share acquisition by Putra Borneo Agro on 20 Jan 2026. The transaction involved 244.5mn shares purchased at an average price of IDR777 per share, amounting to a total investment of IDR190.0 bn. This acquisition increases Putra Borneo Agro's ownership in the palm oil producer to 8.3% stake, up from the previous 5.7% stake. Management noted that the transaction is intended for long-term investment purposes, signaling institutional confidence in the company's CPO production outlook for 2026. (Source: EmitenNews)

**FORE – To open more than 60 stores in 2026**

Fore Kopi Indonesia (FORE) expects to continue its store expansions this year and plans to open more than 60 stores, which mainly will be in tier-2 and tier-3 cities. These outlets will also include Fore Donut stores, which will expand beyond the Greater Jakarta (Jabodetabek) area. As of 3Q25, FORE operated more than 300 stores across 50 cities in Indonesia. (Source : Kontan)
