

MARKET COMMENTARY

U.S. markets closed mixed in Monday's (6/8), with DJIA (-0.16%), S&P 500 and Nasdaq gained (+0.30%) and (+0.86%), respectively. The gains were driven by strength in semiconductor stocks, led by Micron Technology, which surged 10%, followed by NVIDIA and Broadcom. On the geopolitical front, President Donald Trump worked to maintain the fragile ceasefire amid continued exchanges of strikes between Iran and Israel. From a macroeconomic perspective, investors are awaiting the release of U.S. April trade balance data today (6/9). Meanwhile, the U.S. 10-year Treasury yield rose (+31 bps) to 4.57%, while the U.S. Dollar Index edged lower to 100.05.

In Europe, the Stoxx 600 closed slightly lower by (-0.15%), as oil prices pared earlier gains following signs of a pause in attacks between Iran and Israel.

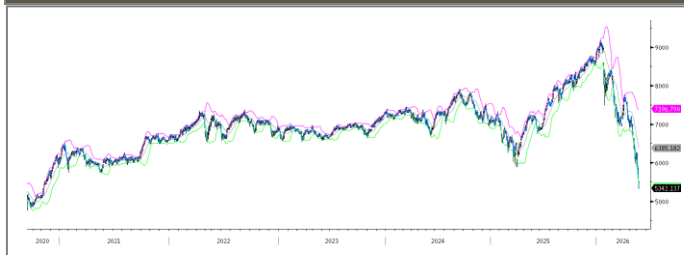
In the commodities market, WTI crude oil rose(+1.03%) to USD91.84 per barrel, while Brent crude gained (+1.25%)to USD94.25 per barrel. Coal increased (+1.68%) to USD151.25 per ton, while gold and nickel declined (-0.26%) and (-0.98%), respectively.

Asian markets closed lower yesterday (6/8), including JCI, which plunged (-4.52%) to 5,342.1. Foreign investors recorded a net sell of IDR587.2 bn in the regular market and a net buy of IDR140.1 bn in the negotiated market. Meanwhile, the IDR weakened (-0.9%) to IDR 18,178 against the USD. We expect the JCI to remain under pressure today amid mixed global sentiment and the potential continuation of rupiah weakness.

**TLKM – To disburse cash dividend of IDR21.9 tn for FY25**

Telkom Indonesia (TLKM) via its AGMS on 8 Jun '26 approved the company's plan to disburse IDR21.9 tn in cash dividends or IDR222.08/share from its FY25 normalized net profit of IDR22.7 tn (reported net profit: IDR17.8 tn). At the closing price of IDR2,350/share, the implied dividend yield stands at 9.45%. The cum-dividend date is set for 17 Jun '26 in the regular and negotiated markets, with payment scheduled on 10 Jul '26. Separately, The Bank of New York Mellon acquired an additional 29.83mn shares of TLKM on 5 Jun '26 at approximately IDR2,780/share, valued at around IDR82.92 bn. Post-transaction, its total ownership in TLKM stands at 6.13bn shares or a 6.20% stake. (Source: EmitenNews)

**PJAA – Launches school holiday program to boost visitor traffic**

Pembangunan Jaya Ancol (PJAA) has launched a school holiday program themed "Serunya Ga Abis-Abis" running from 20 Jun–12 Jul '26, targeting higher visitor traffic through bundled ticket promos and event activations across Dufan, Sea World, Samudra, and Jakarta Bird Land. As a precursor, PJAA is offering free admission from 8–19 Jun '26 (16:00–23:00 WIB) in conjunction with Jakarta's 499th anniversary celebrations. Promotional offers during the school holiday period include Dufan ticket bundles with Susu Mbok Darmi, Sea World + Samudra + Jakarta Bird Land bundles with IDR15,000 merchandise vouchers, a Buy 4 Get 1 Free promo, and discounts for visitors arriving via Transjakarta. **PTPP – Secures IDR143.09 bn contract to build RSUD in Mamuju Tengah**

PP Persero (PTPP) secured a contract worth IDR143.09 bn from the Ministry of Health to construct a regional public hospital (RSUD) in Mamuju Tengah, West Sulawesi. The project spans 240 calendar days and involves upgrading the hospital's classification from Type D to Type C, enabling expanded services covering outpatient, inpatient, emergency, and supporting medical facilities. Management stated the project reflects PTPP's commitment to supporting equitable national development in the healthcare infrastructure sector. (Source:EmitenNews)

**KEEN – To disburse IDR30.1 bn in dividends**

Kencana Energi Lestari (KEEN) approved a cash dividend distribution of IDR30.1 bn, equivalent to IDR8.22 per share, for FY25 following shareholder approval at its Annual General Meeting of Shareholders (AGMS). The dividend is supported by the company's FY25 net profit attributable to shareholders of USD9.1 mn. The cum dividend date in the regular and negotiated market is scheduled for 15 Jun '26, while dividend payment will be made on 3 Jul '26. (Source: EmitenNews)

**CBDK – To disburse IDR28.3 bn in dividends**

Bangun Kosambi Sukses (CBDK) approved a cash dividend distribution of IDR28.3 bn, equivalent to IDR5 per share, during its Annual General Meeting of Shareholders (AGMS). The dividend is approximately 20x the company's FY25 net profit attributable to shareholders of IDR1.36 bn, supported by retained earnings. The cum dividend date in the regular and negotiated market is scheduled for 12 Jun '26, while dividend payment will be made on 8 Jul '26. (source: IDX Channel)

**GULA - Controlling shareholder increases ownership to 55.17%**

Aman Agrindo (GULA) announced that its controlling shareholder, PT Aman Resources Indonesia, purchased 37.7 mn shares at IDR264 per share on 4 Jun '26. The transaction, valued at approximately IDR9.95 bn, was executed for direct investment purposes. Following this transaction, PT Aman Resources Indonesia's ownership in the company increased to 55.17% (590.5 mn shares) from its previous stake of 51.65% (552.8 mn shares). (Source - Investor)

**WIFI - Explores IDR2.5 tn bond issuance to fund subsidiary capex**

Solusi Sinergi Digital (WIFI) is exploring the issuance of Phase I 2026 Shelf-Registered Bonds and Sukuk Ijarah, each valued at IDR1.25 tn, with the bookbuilding period running until 17 Jun '26. The instruments will be offered in three series with tenors of 370 days, two years, and three years. The entire proceeds will be channeled to its subsidiary, Telemedia Komunikasi Pratama (TKP), as capital expenditure (capex) to develop Fixed Wireless Access (FWA) networks across Java. The funds will be allocated to purchase Customer Premises Equipment (CPE) and Radio Access Network (RAN) units, as well as to cover installation costs. To support its long-term expansion, TKP has allocated a total capex of IDR26.2 tn until 2031 to install 5,500 RAN sites and serve 3.7 mn customers. (Source - IDNFinancials)

**IRRA - Focuses on expanding medical device distribution network**

Itama Ranoraya (IRRA) will continue to focus on market and distribution networks expansion, this year in order to support long term growth. To achieve this, IRRA plans to increase sales capacity and distribution points across regions, establish strategic partnerships with private and government entities, and focus on the sales of domestic medical devices (AKD) to substitute imports, alongside developing advanced medical technologies such as minimally invasive surgery. In FY25, IRRA's revenue and net profit grew by 12.55% YoY and 23.03% YoY to IDR1.1 tn and IDR65.53 bn, respectively. The top-line growth was primarily driven by the sales of in vitro diagnostic products, which contributed IDR693.48 bn, followed by sterile electromedical devices. (Source - Kontan)

**EMAS – Announces maiden Kolokoa MRE**

Merdeka Gold Resources (EMAS) has announced its maiden Mineral Resource Estimate (MRE) for the Kolokoa Prospect. As of 1 June '26, Kolokoa holds an estimated 42 mn tonnes of mineral resources at a grade of 0.33 g/t gold, translating to approximately 445,000 ounces of gold. This discovery successfully boosts the total Resources (M&I) inventory of the Pani Gold Mine by around 6%, from 7.0 mn ounces to approximately 7.4 mn ounces. Management highlighted that this milestone was achieved in just six months and strongly supports EMAS's long-term growth strategy, including its ambition to scale peak production up to 500,000 ounces per year.

**SMDR – Golden Star 1 container ship sinks**

Samudera Indonesia (SMDR) reported that the Golden Star 1 container ship, operated by its subsidiary Samudera Shipping Line, sank on June 5, 2026. The vessel served the Singapore–Malaysia route. As of now, all crew members have been safely evacuated. SMDR is also preparing a replacement vessel to continue serving the route. (Source : Kontan)

**Metal mining – Gross split scheme confirmed to oil & gas**

Minister of Energy and Mineral Resources (ESDM) Bahlil Lahadalia has explicitly confirmed that the gross split profit-sharing scheme will remain exclusive to the upstream oil and gas (migas) sector and will not be adopted for the mineral and coal mining (minerba) sector. This statement firmly puts to rest recent market speculation — previously fueled by internal ESDM studies evaluating a potential 70:30 gross split in favor of the government for mining operations. Bahlil emphasized that existing mining regulations will remain unchanged to ensure legal and business certainty. Previously, discussions regarding an overhaul of the mining profit-sharing system had been considered as a means to optimize state revenues; however, the government noted that any such evaluation involves multiple considerations, including technical, economic, and state revenue assessments, with no formal decision reached to date. **Comment:**

*The confirmation that the gross split scheme will not be applied to the minerba sector is a positive regulatory relief for mining companies, particularly those with high operating cost structures, as the previously studied scheme would have significantly compressed profit margins. However, risks remain as the government has not fully closed the door on alternative profit-sharing reviews to optimize state revenues — warranting continued monitoring from investors.*
